Papers submitted for refereeing are due on or before **6 July 2007**. Please submit your paper for refereeing to the relevant Stream Coordinator as an attachment via email (preferably as a Word document saved as RTF). The refereeing process will be in accordance with DEST guidelines.

Papers should be from 5000 to 8000 words in length.
