

APSA WORKSHOP PROGRAM

APSA uses part of its accumulated reserves to sponsor a research workshop program.

APSA members are invited to apply for funding, bearing in mind the following.

1. Eligibility of workshop applicants will normally be restricted to members of APSA to encourage a broadening of and increase in membership
2. Workshop convenors are expected to put plans to editors of AJPS and to explore the likelihood of AJPS publishing the proceedings as a special issue.
3. No more than two workshops will be funded in any one year.
4. The program is open to all APSA members on a competitive basis.
5. Total funds available in any one year will be determined by the Executive in the light of the Association's cash flow. We hope to provide \$5-10k per workshop.
6. Special consideration will be given for applications from early career researchers or those applications that offer matching funds

Conditions of award

APSA Workshop awards will support the following items of expenditure associated with the running of the workshop.

- fares for participants from within Australia (but not from New Zealand)
- accommodation for non-local participants
- catering of lunch, morning and afternoon teas and a conference dinner
- specified printing and administration costs

APSA will not normally support

- cost of venue hire
- alcohol
- speakers' fees
- international airfares

Closing date

Applications for funding in the current round must be submitted by 30 May 2007

Applications

- The APSA executive will assess the proposals and make the necessary awards coopting expert advice when necessary. The editors of AJPS will also be consulted.
- The Executive Committee will report to the AGM on the competition.
- Within 2 months of completion of workshop, workshop organisers will provide APSA with a written report on the Workshop, including a budgetary statement, a list of participants, and plans for publication of all or some of the papers.
- The workshop reports will be available on the web site.
